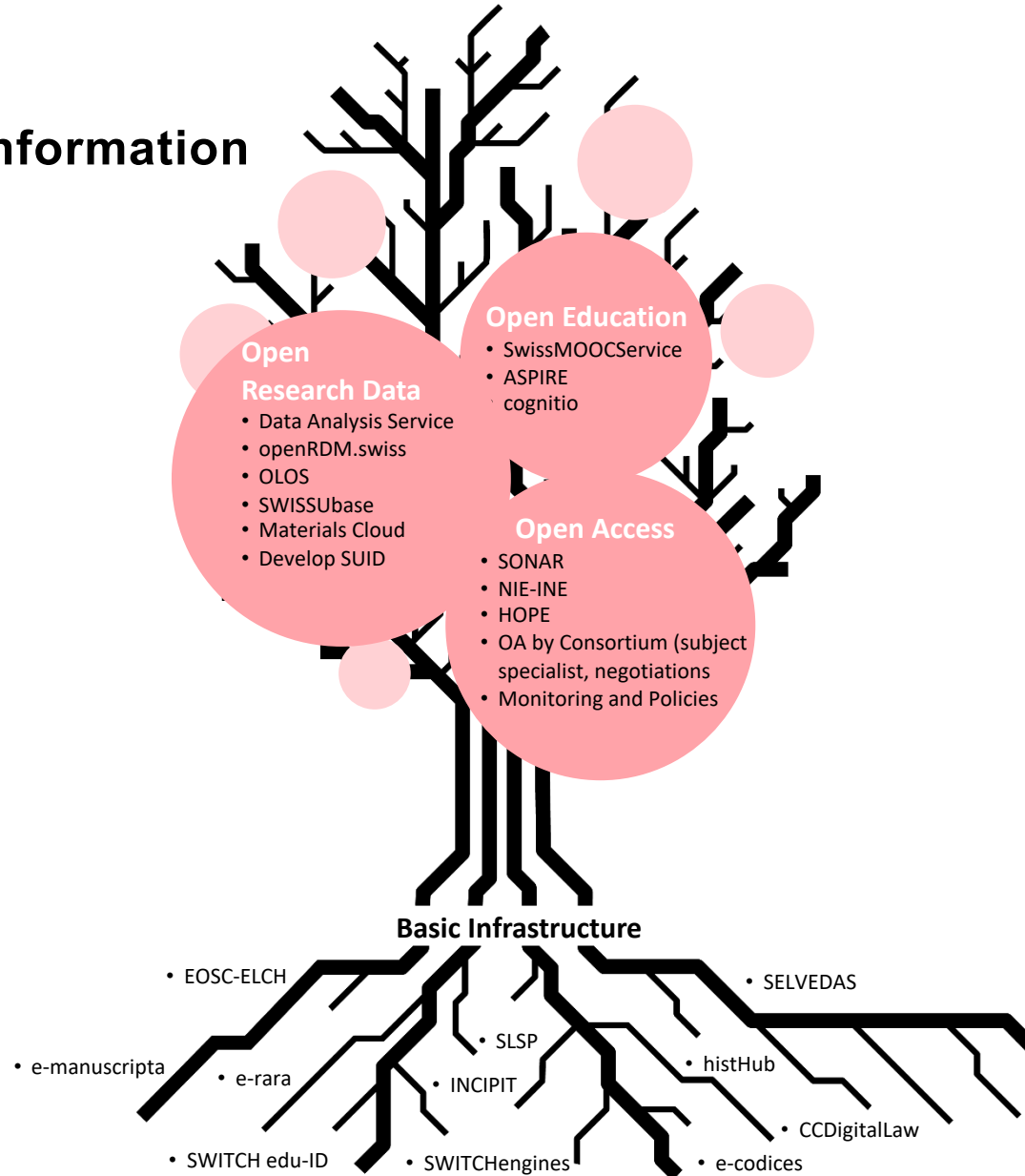

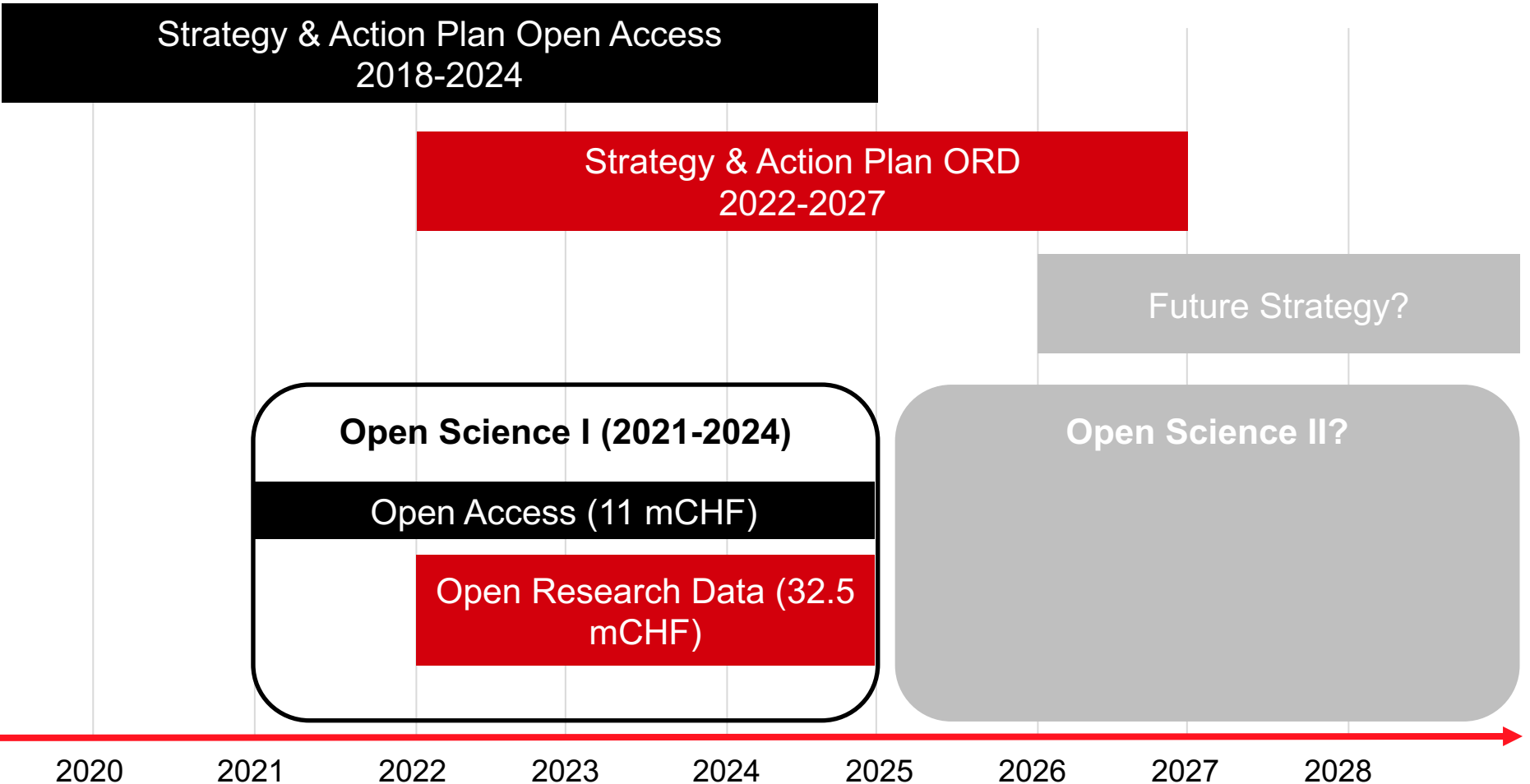

The Open Science Programme



Programme Structure & Implementation Methods

- Structure based on 10 “Action Lines”
- Each Action Line can support several actions
- 2 methods:
 - Bottom-up -> Actions are proposed by beneficiaries based on the provided description in the implementation plan (50% matching fund required)
 - Top-down -> Actions are proposed by beneficiaries based on additional specifications (produced by a specification provider)
- Actions covering multiple action lines are possible

Practical Aspects

Eligibility

- Eligible for funding: members of swissuniversities and their affiliates - see [List](#)
- 50% matching funds from the partners (at program level)
- 4 research institutes of the ETH Domain (EAWAG, WSL, EMPA and PSI) can apply to the ETH Board President for a direct co-funding.
- Other partners are welcome to participate, with their own resources, or as subcontracting parties of an eligible partner.

Action Line Example: Setting up of shared services & e-infrastructures

- Typical Actions:
 - develop repository solutions as shared services and e-infrastructures
 - promote the usage of repository solutions compliant with OA policies
 - set-up the necessary researchers' support for using such resources.
- Project Typical Duration: 2-3 years
- Estimated budget: 3 mCHF from the OS Program (+3 mCHF HEI)
